1.Context and Rationale

Formal Framework of COVE-WENDT Partnership

Deliverable **D4.2: Business–education partnership agreements for collaboration in the skills ecosystem** outlines and brings together the formal framework for the COVE-WENDT partnership. This framework is designed to broaden the **skills ecosystem** and strengthen the connection between **education, innovation, and industrial needs** in welding and non-destructive testing (NDT).

Practical Means for Network Growth and Extension

At its core, the agreement offers practical methods for COVE-WENDT partners in each country to **grow and extend the CoVE network** according to **regional priorities** and strategic directions for industrial development. These priorities are tailored to each partner country's unique context, encompassing workforce requirements, industrial areas of focus, the shift toward greener practices, and ongoing digital transformation.

Shared Approach to Industrial Collaboration

The agreements presented in this deliverable establish a reliable, unified approach for engaging with industrial companies. Through this approach, businesses are encouraged to bring forward specific challenges to the COVE-WENDT network. In response, COVE-WENDT partners leverage their expertise, training programs, and living lab resources to **identify, co-design, test, and validate innovative solutions** tailored to those challenges.

2. Objective

The main goal of the D4.2 business–education cooperation agreements is to grow the COVE-WENDT network and deliver innovative solutions to industry partners. These agreements offer industrial companies, especially those facing cost, skills, or compliance challenges, practical support through training, facility access, and expert advice, with solutions tested in living labs. The project aims to collect at least 25 solved industrial cases per country, requiring ongoing collaboration beyond signing. These agreements are the starting point for use-case development within living labs and the broader CoVE ecosystem.

3. Collaboration Agreements

The project uses a standard **Collaboration Agreement** between a **CoVE Partner** and an **Industrial Partner**, ensuring consistent cooperation across the consortium despite regional differences. The agreement outlines clear offers and commitments for both sides:

- **Training Opportunities:** Industrial partners can nominate staff for free training in digital welding and green industry topics.
- **Access to Living Labs:** Companies gain structured access to facilities for testing solutions with expert support, within project limits and safety rules.
- **Networking:** Partners join a European network of Centres of Vocational Excellence, supporting knowledge sharing and partnerships.

The template specifies collaboration terms, including duration (project period plus 36 months), quality and safety standards, confidentiality, GDPR compliance, and intellectual property rights.

4. How the agreements operate in the skills ecosystem

The D4.2 agreements are valuable because they foster ongoing collaboration rather than serving as mere formalities. Once a company joins the network by signing an agreement, a phase of practical cooperation is initiated, enabling both parties to work together toward tangible outcomes.

Industrial partners are encouraged to present real operational challenges, such as issues with welding quality, productivity, a need for greener techniques, advanced automation, digital monitoring, or reliable inspection and non-destructive testing (NDT) procedures. COVE-WENDT partners actively collaborate with these companies to develop use cases, identify potential solutions, and assemble relevant expertise and facilities to address these challenges.

Living labs play an essential role in this collaborative process. The agreements provide opportunities to test innovative ideas within controlled environments that closely resemble real industrial settings. Solutions can be refined, assessed against safety and quality standards, and validated with input from both industry professionals and learners. This approach not only promotes innovation but also strengthens skill development: company staff improve their competencies through focused training and practical sessions, while learners and trainers gain firsthand experience by tackling authentic industry problems.

By repeating this collaborative cycle, the project aims to build a portfolio of **resolved industrial cases** with a target of at least 25 per country in the coming years, while enhancing the network's impact and credibility within each region.

5. Monitoring relevance and KPI logic

D4.2 contributes to project monitoring through two distinct yet complementary methods. Firstly, the agreements serve as measurable outputs, allowing the consortium to track the number of agreements established in each country and the diversity of industrial partners participating. This quantitative data provides clear insight into the scale and reach of the collaboration.

Secondly, the agreements are intentionally structured to be implemented and converted into actionable outcomes. This aspect of monitoring focuses on qualitative and outcome-oriented indicators. Effectiveness is evaluated by considering metrics such as the number of nominated participants who have received training, the total number of living lab sessions conducted, the count of company use cases that have been addressed, and the number of cases that have been resolved and documented through the ecosystem's mechanisms.

This methodology is aligned with the project's comprehensive stakeholder engagement strategy. It highlights the importance of monitoring cooperation agreements not only in terms of quantity but also by assessing their tangible contributions to the overall impact within the skills ecosystem.

In this context, the action foresees the establishment of 25 cooperation agreements with industry to strengthen the regional and transnational skills ecosystems in welding and NDT. At the present reporting stage, the Italian partners have not been able to secure all the agreements.

This number reflects a deliberate strategic sequencing rather than a lack of engagement. The Italian consortium prioritised the consolidation and validation of the core educational outputs, including curricula development, innovative training materials, pilot courses and blended delivery models, before scaling up the formalisation of industrial agreements. This approach ensured that cooperation proposals were based on concrete, tested and market-aligned training solutions, rather than preliminary concepts.

During this development phase, multiple companies, including SMEs and large manufacturing actors active in welding, fabrication and inspection, were engaged through bilateral meetings, pilot course presentations and living lab discussions. Although not all of these interactions have yet resulted in formally signed agreements, companies provided substantial and constructive technical feedback. This included requests for the inclusion of modules on AI-based weld monitoring and digital quality traceability, stronger integration of energy efficiency and CO₂ reduction strategies in welding operations, incorporation of advanced NDT case studies such as phased array and digital radiography, preference for short and stackable micro-credentials linked to specific industrial competences, alignment of practical training schedules with production constraints, and increased emphasis on repair, remanufacturing and circular economy practices.

This feedback has already been integrated into the refined training offer and cooperation framework, thereby strengthening the relevance and sustainability of future agreements.

Now that curricula and pilot activities are fully structured and available to the industrial community, a targeted engagement campaign is underway in Italy to formalise partnerships with previously consulted companies and new stakeholders. Based on the advanced stage of discussions and the positive responses received, the Italian partners expect to significantly increase the number of signed agreements in the coming months and move towards the overall project target.

Given the active involvement of the partners in the project, a number of 103 agreements have been concluded to date, exceeding the initial target KPI: 100 agreements.

The distribution by country / ecosystem is as follows:

- Hungary: 28 collaboration agreements
- Romania: 32 collaboration agreements
- Italy: 18 collaboration agreements
- Spain: 25 collaboration agreements.

Therefore, the current number of agreements should be interpreted within the framework of a quality-driven implementation strategy, ensuring that cooperation agreements generate measurable impact, operational use cases and long-term ecosystem sustainability rather than serving solely as numerical outputs.
